<b>11</b>	<p><b>Update from WSDC/SCC</b> BT want to lose phone boxes. Tim Burton is dealing with the issue at WSDC. Theresa May to give a decision about Hinkley Point C by end of September. KT indicated that proposed merger of WSDC and Taunton Deane was a merger in principle. The councils would cease and a new council would be formed. The merger would not take place until 2019. The Boundary commission would get involved revising the number of wards from 82 to 50. The local tips will require people using trailers to unload rubbish to apply for permits.</p>
