A total of £10,129.04 was transferred. A payment was made to SALC for £122.71 and 3 lots of £4.25 charges were made for April to June.</p> <p>However the Community Instant Access account was not possible to transfer; it has a total of £1093.10 as at the 9th June 25. Last month it earned 73 pence interest. Eventually Dot was advised to complete a closure form from Lloyds, which has been countersigned by Louise and Mary, this will close the account and put all the money in the new Nat West account.
